This Workshop is designed to review the use of bacteria in the treatment of brackish groundwaters that may not be easily treated using conventional treatment systems. Biofiltration followed by RO membranes is fast becoming a common treatment option in the province. The care and operation of the biofilters is discussed, as well as a half day discussion on membrane processes and maintenance. This workshop is ideal for anyone interested in emerging technologies or working with a biofiltration plant.
